Day 1- Palekh

Journey to Palekh Russia and paint the Russian Fairy Tale Father Frost and the Maiden.

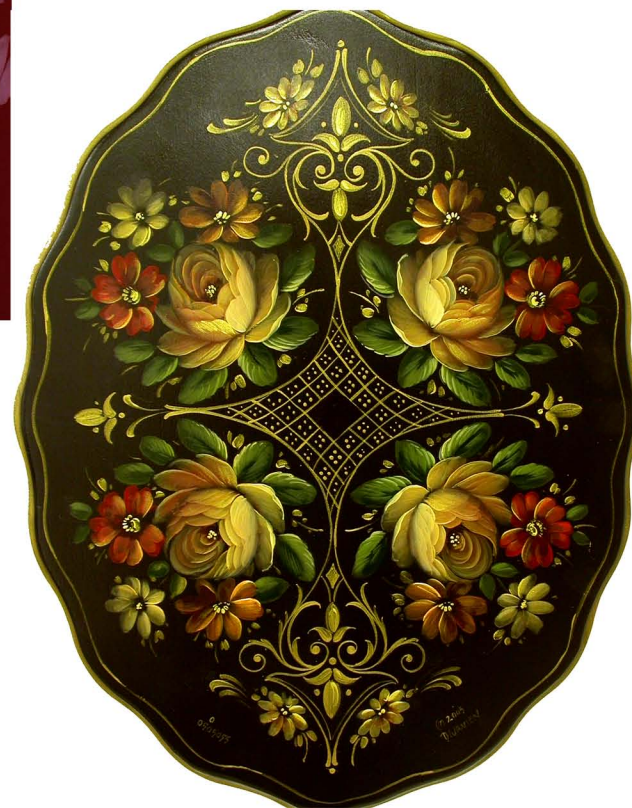
Learn the history of the style and the 4 styles of fairy tale painting. Palekh, Kholui, Mstera and Fedoskino. Patterns for a traditional carved Santa and the box shown will be provided.

Day 2- Floral Sampler

We will paint samples of 2 styles.

The Begonias is a technique made famous by Balthasar van der Ast. We will study his layering and petal progressions. Next we will head to England and study the stroke combinations used to build the stylized stroke florals seen on this table top.

Patterns for all pieces will be included.





Day 3- Opmaken Technique

This famous technique was first used by Michelangelo in the late 15th century.

Opmaken was also used and made famous by Vermeer. The process is composed of light background followed by a building of the hues directly in each area.

We will apply this technique to these flowers, studying the mass tone of each color as it is applied.

Fun and fast to paint once you understand the process!

Day 4- Chippen-Dutch

I call this technique Chippen-Dutch.

This technique is a blend of the Dutch layering process, and the light underpainting of the Chippendale technique.

The pieces uses the best and the fastest painting portions of each technique. The background is built using the traditional hounding as the flowers near completion.

Patterns for both pieces will be included along with design ideas for additional pieces
